develop specific sectors of the Indian economy and public life. They are responsible for maintaining orderly markets, protecting consumers and investors, enforcing laws and standards, promoting fair competition, ensuring safety and transparency, and supporting the long-term development of their respective sectors. Depending on their legal mandate, Indian regulators may exercise powers relating to licensing, registration, supervision, inspection, standard-setting, tariff determination, investigation, enforcement and adjudication d48d6e3c39

The importance of institutional credit in boosting rural economy has been clear to the Government of India right from its early stages of planning. Bharatiya Reserve Bank Note Mudran (BRBNM) is a specialised division of RBI through which it prints and mints Indian

currency notes (INR) in two of its currency printing presses located in Mysore (Karnataka; Southern India) and Salboni (West Bengal; Eastern India). Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation was established by RBI as one of its specialized division for the purpose of providing insurance of deposits and guaranteeing of credit facilities to all Indian banks.

The term of office typically runs for three years and can, in some cases, be extended for another two years.

The Registrar of Companies lists its earliest date of incorporation in 1901. From the time of its founding in 1927, Palai Central Bank had an eventful history. The bank's existence was during the period preceding and immediately following India's independence when Kerala – a small state in the far south – exerted very little influence in national policy. It was also a period when the need to protect the interests of different segments of society was not a major consideration when the central government made policy decisions.

officials of the Reserve Bank of India and three external members nominated by the Government of India. They need to observe a "silent period" seven days before and after the rate decision for "utmost confidentiality". The Governor of the Reserve Bank of India is the chairperson ex officio of the committee. Decisions are taken by majority with the governor having the casting vote in case of a tie.
