Stretching is usually done in small increments to minimize the potential for damaging the healed fistula or creating scar tissue. In North America, the American wire gauge system is used, and most stretching methods go up by a single even-sized gauge increment at a time. 0g (8 mm), is generally considered to be "the point of no return": a hole larger than this size will rarely close to a standard piercing size. Since each body is different, any stretched piercings, no matter the size, should be approached as a permanent body modification. beginning to experiment with piercing parts of their bodies. The first pierced navels most likely belonged to men and were adorned with masculine jewelry...

Industrial piercings first appeared in the early 1990s when they were first invented by Erik Dakota along with the Daith piercing and Rook piercing. The first reference to the industrial piercing was in a 1992 edition of Body Play magazine, which referred to this piercing as the "industrial ear project."

The procedure is done similarly to other piercings of the cartilage of the ear. Clamps may be used but it is usually done freehand. Once the area is cleaned, the piercer and the client will agree on placement, although because of its location it can be difficult to see exactly where the entrance and exit holes will be. Generally, the piercer will advise the client on the best location...

== History ==

Forward helix piercing: The area of the helix closest to the head; generally any piercing between the apex of the helix and where the helix joins the head.

The history of navel piercing has been misrepresented, as many of the myths promulgated by Doug

Malloy in the pamphlet *Body & Genital Piercing in Brief* continue to be reprinted. For instance, according to Malloy's colleague Jim Ward, Malloy alleged that navel piercing was popular among ancient Egyptian aristocrats and was depicted in Egyptian statuary, an allegation that is widely repeated. However, other sources deny that the historical record supports the allegation.

Pre-modern genital piercings were most culturally widespread in Southeast Asia, where it had been part of traditional practice since ancient times. The main motive is beautification and individualization; in addition, some piercings enhance sexual pleasure by increasing stimulation. Anal, guiche, and pubic piercings do not involve perforation of genitalia itself.

Barbells, curved barbells and captive bead rings are the common jewelry types worn in eyebrow piercings. Each of these jewelry types put varying degrees of

pressure on the piercing, which can cause irritation or piercing migration over time. The larger the gauge used in the piercing, the less likely the piercing is to be rejected or accidentally torn out. Sixteen gauge piercings and jewelry is common.

Antihelix: The raised ridge of cartilage between the helix and ear canal.

Ear piercing and nose piercing have been particularly widespread and are well represented in historical records and among grave goods. The oldest mummified remains ever discovered had earrings, attesting to the existence of the practice more than 5,000 years ago. Nose piercing is documented as far back as 1500 BCE. Piercings of these types have been documented globally, while lip and tongue piercings were historically found in some African cultures. Nipple and genital piercing have also been practiced by various cultures, with nipple piercing dating back at least to Ancient Rome while genital piercing is described...

Industrial piercing: Two piercings joined by a single piece of jewelry, usually a barbell, commonly with one piercing in the helix and the other in the forward helix, though other multiple-

piercing placements may still be termed industrials. Locations for piercings other than the earlobe include the rook, tragus, and across the helix (see image in the infobox). The simple term "ear piercing" usually refers to an earlobe piercing, whereas piercings in the upper part of the external ear are often referred to as "cartilage piercings". Cartilage piercings are more complex to perform than earlobe piercings and take longer to heal. Procedure

Rook (piercing) It is located just above the tragus on the ridge between the inner and outer conch with the piercing passing from the underside to the top of this ridge, differing from many ear piercings that essentially span between a "front" and "back" surface. The piercing was first named in issue #4 of the magazine *Body Play and Modern Primitives Quarterly* (published by Fakir Musafar) around 1992 alongside the first printed reference to the industrial piercing, then termed "industrial ear project". Erik Dakota, a well known professional piercer and the individual responsible for originating and popularizing the rook piercing, is said to

have named this modification after a shortened version of his first name. A rook piercing is a perforation of the antihelix of the ear for the purpose of wearing jewelry. Earring components may be made of any number of materials, including metal, plastic, glass, precious stone, beads, wood, bone, and other materials. Designs range from small hoops and studs to large plates and dangling items. The size is ultimately limited by the physical capacity of the earlobe to hold the earring without tearing. Piercing guns have been widely criticized as dangerous among professional body piercers. The use of older designs of piercing gun can possibly carry an increased risk of disease transmission, as compared to methods used by professional piercers. Piercing guns have been criticised for causing damage (sometimes mischaracterised as blunt-force trauma) to the skin and underlying tissue. Diminished air and blood circulation in tissue compressed by a piercing gun can lead to prolonged healing, minor complications and scarring.

History

A horizontal piercing of the eyebrow is known as a horizontal eyebrow piercing.

Eye eyebrow piercing

After the piercing is completed, the healing process takes a minimum of six weeks to eight weeks for the wound to close. An eyebrow piercing is a vertical surface piercing, wherein a twelve to eighteen gauge cannula needle is inserted through the bottom of the eyebrow and exits through the top of the eyebrow to permit insertion of jewelry. A curved barbell is the most common jewelry inserted post-piercing.

Those performing the piercing may use a Pennington clamp to better guide the needle through the skin. Piercing the eyebrow is safe 2cbffe78a1
