

Where Is A Bladder

Bladder In humans, the bladder is a distensible organ that sits on the pelvic floor. In humans and other placental mammals, urine enters the bladder via the ureters and exits via the urethra. The typical adult human bladder will hold between 300 and 500 ml (10 and 17 fl oz) before the urge to urinate occurs, but it can hold considerably more. Those whose bladder tumors have not spread outside the bladder have the best prognoses. These tumors are typically surgically removed, and the person is treated with chemotherapy or one of several immune-stimulating therapies. Those whose tumors continue to grow, or whose tumors have penetrated the bladder muscle, often have their bladder surgically removed (radical cystectomy). People whose tumors have spread beyond the bladder have the worst prognoses; on average they survive a year from diagnosis. These people are treated with chemotherapy and immune checkpoint inhibitors, followed...

Swim bladder The ventral position of the swim bladder means that the center of mass is above the center of buoyancy, reducing stability but improving maneuverability. Neurogenic bladder dysfunction In addition to symptomatic treatment, treatment depends on the nature of the underlying disease and can be managed with behavioral changes, medications, surgeries, or other procedures. There are multiple types of neurogenic bladder depending on the underlying cause and the symptoms. Neurogenic bladder dysfunction, often called by the shortened term neurogenic bladder, was technically termed neurogenic lower urinary tract dysfunction by the International Continence Society. Neurogenic bladder can be diagnosed through a history and physical as well as imaging and more specialized testing. It refers to urinary bladder problems due to disease or injury of the central nervous system or peripheral nerves involved in the control of urination. A range of diseases or conditions can cause neurogenic bladder including spinal cord injury, multiple sclerosis, stroke, brain injury, spina bifida, peripheral nerve damage, Parkinson's disease, multiple system atrophy or other neurodegenerative diseases. Symptoms include overactive bladder, urinary urgency, frequency, incontinence or difficulty passing urine. The symptoms of neurogenic bladder, especially incontinence, can severely degrade a person's

Standard tanks are designed for land based use and operations, but can be used in marine settings and in aviation... == References == Standard fuel bladder tanks sizes range from 100-US-gallon (380 L) to 200,000-US-gallon (760,000 L) capacities and larger. Custom fuel storage bladders and cells are available, although at sizes exceeding 50,000 US gallons (190,000 L) there is an increased spill risk. To minimize the risk of leakage, and for the sake of containing a catastrophic spill, all fuel bladders should be housed in secondary containment (bundling). The use of fuel bladders without precautionary measures is risky and should not be undertaken. The EPA has set clear guidelines for the use of secondary containment concerning fuel bladders and imposes fines for discharging of fuel into the environment.

Bladder outlet obstruction This process of decreased flow of urine through the urinary tract can begin as early as during intrauterine life and it prevents normal development of fetal kidneys and fetal urine. Decreased flow of urine leads to swelling of the urinary tract, called hydronephrosis. their bladder is full or when they exercise. Bladder outlet obstruction (or obstructive uropathy) occurs when urine is unable to flow from the kidneys through the ureters and out of the bladder through the urethra. Bladder neck obstruction is a condition where the bladder neck does not open enough during voiding. Older children and adults can also experience bladder outlet obstruction; however, this process is usually reversible and isn't associated with as many poor outcomes as in infants with congenital bladder outlet obstruction. Low levels of fetal urine leads to low amniotic fluid levels and incomplete lung maturation

The first engineered flexible bladder tank was constructed from rubber in 1926 and manufactured by John Boyd Dunlop in Manchester UK, then later made from modern materials such polymers, and from PVC in Algeria, Africa in the 1950s. It was invented by André Labaronne (patent N°1.460.825, 19 October 1965) and marketed under the brand CITAF (Citernes pour l'agriculture Française). 460bf6c24e Urinary frequency is defined as urinating more than about 7-8 times in one day. The frequent need to urinate may occur during the day, at night, or both. Bladder cancer Bladder cancer is the abnormal growth of cells in the bladder. Those suspected of having bladder cancer typically have their bladder inspected by a thin medical camera, a procedure called cystoscopy. Most people with bladder cancer are diagnosed after noticing blood in their urine. Suspected tumors are removed and examined to determine if they are cancerous. Bladder exstrophy The underlying embryologic mechanism leading to bladder exstrophy is unknown, though it is thought to be in part due to failed reinforcement of the cloacal membrane by underlying mesoderm. Its presentation is variable, often including abnormalities of the bony pelvis, pelvic floor, and genitalia. Bladder outlet obstruction is classified based on where along the urinary tract the obstruction occurs, including upper urinary tract obstruction and lower urinary tract obstruction. The modern Latin word for "bladder" – cystis – appears in associated terms such as cystitis (inflammation of the bladder). 460bf6c24e As opposed to western medicine, where the bladders function is the storage and excretion of urine, the bladder in traditional Chinese medicine has extended functions, including how fluids are transformed during urine production. Fluids are still sent from the small intestine to the bladder for storage, but the bladder's capabilities are dependent on the kidney yang. If the kidney is yang deficient, the bladder may not have the sufficient qi and heat to transform fluids properly into urine. Charles Darwin remarked upon this in On the Origin of Species, and reasoned that the lung in air-breathing vertebrates had derived from a more primitive swim bladder as a specialized form of enteral respiration. 460bf6c24e Exstrophy means the inversion of a hollow organ. 460bf6c24e Loss of bladder control (urge incontinence) is a form of urinary incontinence characterized by the involuntary loss of urine occurring for no apparent reason while feeling urinary urgency as discussed above, and often occurs with this condition.
