Previte initially turned the request down because he was still trying to get a record deal, and he thought the film was a pornographic film based on the title, but Ienner was persistent, declaring that it would "change his life", and got Previte to write several songs for the film, including "Hungry Eyes", later recorded by singer Eric Carmen, which also became a top 10 hit. 5cd3f063c1 After receiving initial success upon release, the song saw renewed popularity after being featured in the 1999 film Fight Club.
