Appendicitis is primarily caused by a blockage of the hollow portion in the appendix. This blockage typically results from a faecolith, a calcified

"stone" made of feces. Some studies show a correlation between appendicoliths and disease severity. Other factors such as inflamed lymphoid tissue from a viral infection, intestinal parasites, gallstone, or tumors may also lead to this blockage. When the appendix becomes blocked, it experiences increased pressure, reduced blood flow, and bacterial growth, resulting in inflammation. This combination of factors causes tissue injury and, ultimately, tissue death. If this process is left untreated, it can lead to the appendix rupturing, which releases bacteria into the abdominal cavity, potentially leading to severe complications.

In fish, the divisions of the small intestine are not as clear, and the terms anterior intestine or proximal intestine may be used instead of duodenum. In mammals the duodenum may be the principal site for iron absorption.

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Rifampicin Rifampicin may be given either by mouth or intravenously. It is almost always used together with other antibiotics with two notable exceptions: when given as a "preferred treatment that is strongly recommended" for latent TB infection; and when used as post-exposure prophylaxis to prevent *Haemophilus influenzae* type b and meningococcal disease in people who have been exposed to those bacteria. It is generally taken either at least one Rifampicin, also known as rifampin, is an ansamycin antibiotic used to treat several types of bacterial infections, including tuberculosis (TB), *Mycobacterium avium* complex, leprosy, and Legionnaires' disease. Before treating a person for a long period of time, measurements of liver enzymes and blood counts are recommended. Rifampicin should be taken on an empty stomach with a glass of water. due to high rates of hepatotoxicity

An allergic reaction, such as anaphylaxis, or a type of diarrhea caused by *Clostridioides difficile* is possible. Azithromycin causes QT prolongation that may cause life-threatening arrhythmias such as torsades de pointes. While some studies claim that no harm has been found with use during pregnancy, more recent studies with mice during late pregnancy has shown adverse effects on embryonic testicular and neural development of prenatal azithromycin exposure (PAZE). However, there need to be more well-controlled studies in pregnant women. Its safety during breastfeeding is not confirmed, but it is likely safe. Appendicitis Using antibiotics to Appendicitis is inflammation of the appendix. Symptoms commonly include right lower abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, fever and decreased appetite. The cost effectiveness of surgery versus antibiotics is unclear. However, approximately 40% of people do not have these typical symptoms. Severe complications of a ruptured appendix include widespread, painful inflammation of the inner lining of the abdominal wall and sepsis.
