Apple came under some public criticism for releasing the virus with their product. aed1c34ad6 The Storm Worm began attacking thousands of (mostly private) computers in Europe and the United States on Friday, January 19, 2007, using an e-mail message with a subject line about a recent weather disaster, "230 dead as storm batters Europe". During the weekend there were six subsequent waves of the attack. As of January 22, 2007, the Storm Worm accounted for 8% of all malware infections globally. aed1c34ad6 The virus was written up based on code from two different viruses. It can also be spread through removable media, such as CD-ROMs, flash memory, digital cameras and multimedia players. aed1c34ad6 Robert Tappan Morris was a Cornell student, who began work in 1988 on an early Internet worm. He had been given explicit access to a Cornell computer account upon entering the school, and used this access to develop his worm.
