Stretch marks Pregnancy-related striae are known as striae gravidarum. Usually on the belly, these striae also commonly occur on the breasts, thighs, hips, lower back, and buttocks. Over time, they may diminish or change in appearance, but will not disappear completely. Once they have formed, there is no clearly effective treatment, though various methods have been attempted and studied. Striae are caused by tearing of the dermis during periods of rapid growth of the body, such as during puberty or pregnancy, in which they usually form during the last trimester. Over time, they tend to atrophy and lose pigmentation Stretch marks, also known as striae () or striae distensae, are a form of scarring on the skin with an off-color hue.
