The monsoon starts in late June and lasts until mid-September, with about 797.3 mm (31.39 inches) of rain. The average temperatures are around 29 °C (84 °F), although they can vary from around 25 °C (77 °F) on rainy days to 35–40 °C (95–104 °F) during dry spells. The monsoons recede in late September, and the post-monsoon season continues till late October, with average temperatures sliding from 29 to 21 °C (84 to 70 °F).

Delhi Metro The metro has a mix of underground, at-grade, and elevated stations using broad-gauge and standard-gauge tracks. The system consists of 10 colour-coded lines serving 271 stations, with a total length of 374. 466 km (232. In 2023, the operational speed of the Airport Express Line was increased to 120 km/h (75 mph) from 110 km/h (68 mph), making it the fastest metro line in the country. == History == Palam is among the oldest

historically recorded settlements of south-west Delhi and has long been regarded in local tradition as a principal seat of the Solanki Rajputs in the region. According to oral accounts and regional historical traditions, the Solankis are believed to have migrated from Roopnagar near Jaipur during the 11th century and entered the Delhi region during the period of Chauhan ascendancy. They are said to have served as chieftains under the rule of Prithviraj Chauhan, gradually consolidating their influence across the surrounding countryside. Over time, Palam emerged as the leading village of the well-known “Palam Barah”, a confederation of twelve Solanki Rajput villages in south-west Delhi. Construction began in 1998, and the first elevated section (Shahdara to Tis Hazari) on the Red Line opened on 25 December 2002. The first underground section (Vishwavidyalaya to Kashmere Gate on the Yellow Line) opened on 20 December 2004. The network was developed in phases. Phase I was completed by 2006, followed by Phase II in 2011. Phase III was mostly complete by 2021, except for a small extension of the Airport Line, which opened in 2023. Work on Phase IV began on 30 December 2019. The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC), a joint venture between the Government of India and the Government of Delhi, built and operates the Delhi Metro.
