Chernihiv Stadium In October 2011, the stadium received almost €5 million for renovations. In 2008, the stadium was used by Ukraine for the UEFA Women's Olympic Sports Training Center Chernihiv (formerly Yuri Gagarin Stadium) (Ukrainian: Олімпійський навчально-спортивний центр «Чернігів») is a multi-purpose stadium in Chernihiv, Ukraine. on the west stand.
