

Thumb Pain At Wrist

Wrist sprains may occur when a ligament is ruptured or lacerated in severe trauma, stretched or twisted. Commonly, wrist pain is caused by sudden load-bearing or twisting effects, such as falling from a height with an outstretched hand. As a consequence of these various definitions, fractures to the carpal bones are referred to as carpal fractures, while fractures such as distal radius fracture are often considered fractures to the wrist. 4930b00b4d Wrist anatomy includes 20 individual ligaments attaching the eight carpal bones

between the radius and ulna bones of the forearm and the metacarpal bones of the hand. Location and dynamic function of the wrist ligaments determine susceptibility to injury. Wrist structures prone to injury are the triangular fibrocartilage complex and the scapholunate ligament. 4930b00b4d The natural history of De Quervain tendinopathy (what happens without treatment) is a symptom resolution over about an approximate 1 year period. Symptom alleviation (palliative treatment) is provided mainly by splinting the thumb and wrist. Pain medications such as NSAIDs can also be considered. Steroid injections are commonly used, but are not proved to alter the natural history of the condition. Surgery to release the first dorsal component is an option. 4930b00b4d

De Quervain tendinopathy Radial abduction of the thumb is painful. The pathophysiology develops gradually. On some occasions, there is uneven movement or triggering of the thumb and wrist with radial abduction. The characteristic symptoms are pain and tenderness on the thumb side De Quervain syndrome or De Quervain tendinopathy occurs when two tendons that control movement of the thumb become enlarged where they pass through their tendon sheath in the wrist. Wrist permitted in the wrist proper are (muscles in order of importance): Marginal movements: radial deviation (abduction, movement towards the thumb) and ulnar deviation In human anatomy, the wrist is variously defined as (1) the carpus or carpal bones, the complex of eight bones forming the proximal skeletal segment of the hand; (2) the wrist joint or radiocarpal joint, the joint between the radius and the carpus and; (3) the anatomical region surrounding the carpus including the distal parts of the bones of the forearm and the proximal parts of the metacarpus or five metacarpal bones and the series of joints between these bones, thus referred to as wrist joints. This region also includes the carpal tunnel, the anatomical snuff box, bracelet lines, the flexor retinaculum, and the extensor retinaculum 4930b00b4d

Wrist drop The wrist remains partially flexed. Wrist drop is a medical condition in which the wrist and the fingers cannot extend at the metacarpophalangeal joints 4930b00b4d

Watson's test To perform the test, the examiner grasps the wrist with their thumb over the scaphoid tubercle (volar aspect. the scaphoid and lunate bones of the wrist 4930b00b4d
