Animal bites not only include injuries from the teeth of reptiles, mammals, but fish, and amphibians An animal bite is a wound, usually a puncture or laceration, caused by the teeth. Biting is a physical action not only describing an attack but it is a normal response in an animal as it eats, carries objects, softens and prepares food for its young, removes ectoparasites from its body surface, removes plant seeds attached to its fur or hair, scratching itself, and grooming other animals. An animal bite usually results in a break in the skin but also includes contusions from the excessive pressure

Mammalian hosts react to infections with an innate response, often involving inflammation, followed by an adaptive response. b0619a0897 Cat bites are usually considered minor injuries but can result in serious infection and cause rabies if inflicted by a rabid cat. Common symptoms include pain and swelling around the affected area. Sometimes, direct tissue damage from the cat bite can impair mobility or cause tenosynovitis or arthritis. In these cases, surgical consultation is needed to assess severity. Some unusual complications, like deep-vein thrombosis, subcutaneous emphysema and fetal tachycardia have been described. Many of the most prevalent and deadly human diseases are caused by a protozoan infection, including African sleeping sickness, amoebic dysentery, and malaria. b0619a0897 Most spiders do not cause bites that are of importance. For a bite to be significant, substantial envenomation is required. Bites from the widow spiders involve a neurotoxic venom which produces a condition known as latrodectism. Symptoms may include pain which may be at the bite or involve the chest and abdomen, sweating, muscle cramps and vomiting among others. Bites from the recluse spiders cause the condition loxoscelism, in which local necrosis of the surrounding skin and widespread breakdown of red blood cells may occur. Headaches, vomiting and a mild fever may also occur. Other spiders that can cause significant bites include the Australian funnel-web spider and South American wandering spider. b0619a0897

Though uncommon, cat bites can sometimes transmit rabies, cause health complications, and even, though very rarely, lead to death. Bites from cats develop infections more frequently than bites from dogs. *Globicatella* and *Streptococcus* species. Data from the United States show that cat bites represent between 5–15% of all animal bites inflicted to humans, but it has been argued that this figure could be the consequence of under-reporting as bites made by cats are considered by some to be unimportant b0619a0897

For protection against ticks and mosquito bites, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends DEET, icaridin (picaridin, KBR 3023), oil of lemon eucalyptus (OLE), para-menthane-diol (PMD), IR3535 and 2-undecanone with the caveat that higher percentages of the active ingredient provide longer protection. b0619a0897

Mosquito bite allergy Mosquito bite allergies, also termed hypersensitivity to mosquito bites, are excessive reactions of varying severity to mosquito bites. Ordinary mosquito bite allergies are nonetheless detailed here because they are the best understood reactions to mosquito bites and provide a basis for describing what is understood about them. They are allergic hypersensitivity reactions caused by the non-toxic allergenic proteins contained in the saliva injected by a female mosquito (male mosquitos do not take blood-meals) at the

time it takes its blood meal, and are not caused by any toxin or pathogen. By general agreement, mosquito bite allergies do not include the ordinary wheal and flare responses to these bites although these reactions are also allergic in nature. Insect repellent an oral insect repellent against mosquito bites. Pest animals commonly serving as vectors for disease include insects such as flea, fly, and mosquito; and arachnids such as ticks. Insect repellents help prevent and control the outbreak of insect-borne (and other arthropod-borne) diseases such as malaria, Lyme disease, dengue fever, bubonic plague, river blindness, and West Nile fever. However, there is now conclusive evidence that thiamin has no efficacy against mosquito bites.
