

Why Do Babies Cry At Night

Released on March 5, 1971, six months after his death on September 18, 1970, by Reprise Records in the United States and Track Records in the United Kingdom, *The Cry of Love* was successful on the record charts in both countries and was certified platinum by the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) in 1998.
