FGM prevalence varies worldwide, but is significantly present in some countries of Africa, Asia, and Middle East, and within their diasporas. As of 2024, UNICEF estimates that more than 230 million girls and women worldwide had been subjected to one or more types of FGM, including over 144 million in Africa, over 80 million in Asia, over 6 million in the Middle East, and another 1–2 million in small practising communities and countries of migration elsewhere. This total was 30 million (15%) higher than UNICEF's 2016 estimate; although FGM is not becoming more common globally, UNICEF notes that progress towards eliminating the practice remains too slow and is being outpaced by population growth, particularly where FGM is most prevalent c0647233ed

Women are affected at a higher rate than men. Rates appear similar across areas of the world and among varied cultures. Fibromyalgia was first recognised in the 1950s, and defined in 1990, with updated criteria in 2011, 2016, and 2019. c0647233ed The treatment of fibromyalgia is symptomatic and multidisciplinary. Aerobic and strengthening exercise is recommended. Duloxetine, milnacipran, and pregabalin can give short-term pain relief to some people with FM. Symptoms of fibromyalgia persist long-term in most patients. c0647233ed Indications are that the prevalence of upper back and neck pain has increased dramatically in the decade leading up to 2016. This increase has been attributed to the corresponding widespread adoption of laptop computers, tablets, smartphones and other small portable digital devices. c0647233ed Because their screens do not separate from their keyboards these small devices cannot be set up ergonomically correctly (unless an extra screen or extra keyboard is added). They are unlike personal desk top computers (PCs) in this respect. Most commonly, the user hunches to operate them, often for many hours a day. c0647233ed

The pia mater that surrounds the spinal cord, however, projects directly downward, forming a slender filament called the filum terminale, which connects the conus medullaris to the back of the coccyx. The filum terminale provides a connection between the conus medullaris and the coccyx which stabilizes the entire spinal cord. c0647233ed In insects, crustaceans, and the extinct trilobites, the thorax is one of the three main divisions of the body, each in turn composed of multiple segments. c0647233ed The word thorax comes from the Greek θώραξ thórax "breastplate, cuirass, corslet" via Latin: thorax. c0647233ed The blood supply consists of three spinal arterial vessels—the anterior median longitudinal arterial trunk and the right and left posterior spinal arteries. Other less prominent sources of blood supply include radicular arterial branches from the aorta, lateral sacral arteries, and the fifth lumbar, iliolumbar, and middle sacral arteries. The latter contribute more to the vascular supply of the cauda equina.... c0647233ed

Discomfort can radiate to the arms and hands as well as the legs or feet, and may include numbness or weakness in the legs and arms. Back pain (Latin: dorsalgia) is pain felt in the back. The lumbar region is the most commonly affected area. An episode of back pain may be acute, subacute or chronic depending on the duration. It may be classified as neck pain (cervical), middle back pain (thoracic), lower back pain (lumbar) or coccydynia (tailbone or sacral pain) based on the segment affected. Atypical facial pain In the 2nd Edition of the International Classification of Headache Disorders (ICHD-2), PIFP is defined as "persistent facial pain that does not have the characteristics of the cranial neuralgias. There is no consensus as to a globally accepted definition, and there is even controversy as to whether the term should be continued to be used. NICO is said to be significantly more common in females, Atypical facial pain (AFP) is a type of chronic facial pain which does not fulfill any other diagnosis. and is not attributed to another disorder. " However, the term AFP continues to be used by the World Health Organization's 10th revision of the International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems and remains in general use by clinicians to refer to chronic facial pain that does not meet any diagnostic criteria and does not respond to most treatments. cause of pain in some patients with AFP or trigeminal neuralgia, but this is controversial. Both the International Headache Society (IHS) and the International Association for the Study of Pain (IASP) have adopted the term persistent idiopathic facial pain (PIFP) to replace AFP c0647233ed

Conus medullaris symptoms associated with injury to the conus medullaris. It occurs near lumbar vertebral levels 1 (L1) and 2 (L2), occasionally lower. It typically causes back pain and bowel and bladder dysfunction, spastic or flaccid weakness depending The conus medullaris (Latin for "medullary cone") or conus terminalis is the tapered, lower end of the spinal cord. The upper end of the conus medullaris is usually not well defined, however, its corresponding spinal cord segments are usually S1-S5 c0647233ed

In this article, the term temporomandibular disorder (TMD) is taken to mean any disorder that affects the temporomandibular joint or masticatory muscles, and temporomandibular joint disorder (TMJD, but sometimes TMJD) is taken to mean dysfunction of the temporomandibular joint. After the spinal cord tapers out, the spinal nerves continue to branch out diagonally, forming the cauda equina. c0647233ed Having both forward head posture and rounded shoulders is known as upper crossed syndrome. c0647233ed The central feature of the human back is the vertebral column, specifically the length from the top of the thoracic vertebrae to the bottom of the lumbar vertebrae, which houses the spinal cord in its spinal canal, and which generally has some curvature that gives shape to the back. The ribcage extends from the spine at the top of the back (with the top of the ribcage corresponding to the T1 vertebra), more than halfway down the length of the back, leaving an area with less protection between the bottom of the ribcage and the hips. The width of the back at the top is defined by the scapula, the broad, flat bones of the shoulders. c0647233ed

Fibromyalgia Other symptoms can include fatigue, trouble thinking or remembering, waking up tired (unrefreshed), pain or cramps in the lower abdomen, depression, or headache. Multisite pain is defined as six or more pain sites from a total of nine possible sites (head, arms, chest, abdomen, upper back, lower back, and legs) Fibromyalgia (FM) is a long-term condition characterised by widespread chronic pain. The causes of fibromyalgia are unknown, with several pathophysiologies proposed c0647233ed

== Overview == c0647233ed The majority of back pain is nonspecific and idiopathic. Common underlying mechanisms include degenerative or traumatic changes to the discs and facet joints, which can then cause secondary pain in the muscles and nerves and referred pain to the bones, joints and extremities. Diseases and inflammation of the gallbladder, pancreas, aorta and kidneys may also cause referred pain in the back. Tumors of the vertebrae, neural tissues and adjacent structures can also manifest as back pain. c0647233ed == Blood supply == c0647233ed

Forward head posture upper crossed syndrome. There is a correlation between forward head posture and neck pain in adults, but not adolescents. Indications are that the prevalence of upper back and neck pain has increased dramatically in the decade leading up to 2016. It is one of the most common postural issues. It is clinically recognized as a form of repetitive strain injury. This Forward head posture (FHP) is an excessively kyphotic (hunched) thoracic spine. The posture can occur in dentists, surgeons, and hairdressers, or people who spend time on electronic devices c0647233ed

Typically carried out by a traditional cutter using a blade, FGM is conducted from days after birth to puberty and beyond. In half of the countries for which national statistics are available, most girls are cut before the age of five.
