Eye surgery Eye surgery is part of ophthalmology and Eye surgery, also known as ophthalmic surgery or ocular surgery, is surgery performed on the eye or its adnexa. An eye surgeon is responsible for selecting the appropriate surgical procedure for the patient, and for taking the necessary safety precautions. The eye is a fragile organ, and requires due care before, during, and after a surgical procedure to minimize or prevent further damage. Mentions of eye surgery can be found in several ancient texts dating back as early as 1800 BC, with cataract treatment starting in the fifth century BC. It continues to be a widely practiced class of surgery, with various techniques having been developed for treating eye problems. Laser Blended Vision can be achieved through laser eye surgery, usually performed as LASIK, although surface laser eye surgery PRK or LASEK can be used to produce the effect. Laser Blended Vision works by increasing the depth of field of each eye through subtle changes in the optics of the corneal spherical aberration. The increase in depth of field allows for the eyes to be corrected in such a way that the dominant eye is set for distance and intermediate vision while the non-dominant eye sees best in the intermediate to near range. LASIK LASIK surgery is performed by an ophthalmologist who uses a femtosecond laser or a microkeratome to create a corneal flap to expose the corneal stroma and then an excimer laser to reshape the corneal stroma in order to improve visual acuity. 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Limbal relaxing incisions cataract surgery. == Background == 09153b8be4 A computer system tracks the patient's eye position 60 to 4,000 times per second, depending on the specifications of the laser that is used. The computer system redirects laser pulses for precise laser placement. Most modern lasers will automatically center on the patient's visual axis and will pause if the eye moves out of range and then resume ablating at that point after the patient's eye is re-centered. 09153b8be4

Refractive eye surgeries are used to treat common vision disorders such as myopia, hyperopia, presbyopia and astigmatism. This can include various methods of surgical remodeling of the cornea (keratomileusis), lens implantation or lens replacement. The deeper layers of the cornea... 09153b8be4 By contrast, an urgent surgery is one that can wait until the patient is medically stable, but should generally be done within 2 days, and an emergency surgery is one that must be performed without delay; the patient has no choice other than immediate surgery if permanent disability or death is to be avoided. LRI have become the most common technique to correct astigmatism as part of cataract surgery. They are simpler and less expensive than laser surgery such as LASIK or photorefractive keratectomy and avoid the precise placement requirements of toric IOLs. Good results do not require the location and length of the incisions to be highly precise, and the incisions can easily be extended later if the original procedure did not correct all of the astigmatism. 09153b8be4 During cataract surgery, the cloudy natural lens is removed from the posterior chamber of the eye, either by emulsification in place or by manual removal. An IOL (intraocular lens) is usually implanted in its place (PCIOL), or less frequently in the ciliary sulcus, to restore clear vision. Cataract surgery is performed by an ophthalmologist in an out-patient setting at a surgical centre or hospital. Local anaesthesia (injection) or topical anesthesia (drops) are normally used. The procedure is usually quick and causes little or

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no pain and minor discomfort. Photorefractive keratectomy LASEK and PRK permanently change the shape of the anterior central cornea using an excimer laser to ablate (remove by vaporization) a small amount of tissue from the corneal stroma at the front of the eye, just under the corneal epithelium. regenerate after the surgery. The outer layer of the cornea is removed prior to the ablation. The procedure is distinct from LASIK (laser-assisted in-situ keratomileusis), a form of laser eye surgery where a permanent Photorefractive keratectomy (PRK) and laser-assisted sub-epithelial keratectomy (or laser epithelial keratomileusis) (LASEK) are laser eye surgery procedures intended to correct a person's vision, reducing dependency on glasses or contact lenses 09153b8be4

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
