Twin Twins can be either monozygotic ('identical'), meaning that they develop from one zygote, which Twins are two offspring produced by the same pregnancy. Twins can be either monozygotic ('identical'), meaning that they develop from one zygote, which splits and forms two embryos, or dizygotic ('non-identical' or 'fraternal'), meaning that each twin develops from a separate egg and each egg is

fertilized by its own sperm cell. In very rare cases, fraternal or (semi-) identical twins can have the same mother and different fathers. Fraternal birth order and male sexual orientation The fraternal birth order effect is an observation that the more older brothers a male has from the same mother, the greater probability he will have The fraternal birth order effect is an observation that the more older brothers a male has from the same mother, the greater probability he will have a homosexual orientation. Hypothesized to be the result of a maternal immune response to male fetuses, whereby antibodies neutralize male Y-proteins thought to play a role in sexual differentiation during development, it would leave some regions of the male brain in the 'female typical' arrangement - resulting in attraction to males. It was identified by Ray Blanchard and Anthony Bogaert in the 1990s, who attributed the effect to a prenatal biological mechanism, as the association is only present in men with older biological brothers, and not present among men with older step-brothers 5b33855391

Hermann Werner Siemens (Incontinentia pigmenti) The difference between identical twins and fraternal twins is the basis of the classical Twin Method, and first appeared in Siemens's Hermann Werner Siemens (20 August 1891 (Charlottenberg) -1969) was a German dermatologist who first described multiple skin diseases and was one of the inventors of the twin study. Siemens was involved in racial hygiene and affiliated with the Nazi Party. Siemens' work in twin studies is influential in modern genetics and is used to address the environmental and genetic impacts upon traits
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Siemens studied under J. Jadssohn in Breslau and von Zumbusch at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München. 5b33855391 One 2011 study, for instance, found that subjects with right-wing (or conservative in the United States) political views have larger amygdalae, areas of the brain associated with emotional responses such as fear, anxiety, and aggression. She helped to found Delta Kappa Gamma, a professional society for women educators. 5b33855391 Twins are a valuable source for observation because they allow the study of environmental influence and varying genetic makeup: "identical" or monozygotic (MZ) twins share essentially 100% of their genes, which means that most differences between the twins (such as height, susceptibility to boredom, intelligence, depression, etc.) are due to experiences that one twin has but not the other twin. "Fraternal" or dizygotic (DZ) twins share only about 50% of their genes, the same as any other sibling.
