

Treatment For Ovarian Cyst

Cyst A cyst may contain air, fluids, or semi-solid material. A collection of pus is called an abscess, not a cyst. Hence, it is a cluster of cells that have grouped together to form a sac (like the manner in which water molecules group together to form a bubble); however, the distinguishing aspect of a cyst is that the cells forming the "shell" of such a sac are distinctly abnormal (in both appearance and behaviour) when compared with all surrounding cells for that given location. Types == Theca lutein cysts are associated with gestational trophoblastic disease (molar pregnancy), choriocarcinomas, and multiple gestations. In some cases, these cysts may also be associated with diabetes mellitus and alloimmunisation to Rh-D. They have rarely been associated with chronic kidney disease and hyperthyroidism. Other types of ovarian diseases listed in table include endometriosis, ovarian tumors, ovarian cancer, ovarian germ cell tumors, and ovarian low malignant potential tumors. == Etiology ==

Most ovarian cysts are related to ovulation, being either follicular cysts or corpus luteum cysts. Other types include cysts due to endometriosis, dermoid cysts, and cystadenomas. Many small cysts occur in both ovaries in polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS). Pelvic inflammatory disease may also result in cysts. Rarely, cysts may be a form of ovarian cancer. Diagnosis is undertaken by pelvic examination with a pelvic ultrasound or other testing used to gather further details.

Treatment is by surgery to either untwist and fix the ovary in place or to remove it. The ovary will often recover, even if the condition has been present for some time. In those who have had a prior ovarian torsion, there is a 10% chance the other will also be affected. The diagnosis is relatively rare, affecting about 6 per 100,000 women per year. While it most commonly occurs in those of reproductive age, it can occur at any age.

Ovarian cancer Symptoms become more noticeable as the cancer progresses. germ cell tumor may be initially mistaken for a benign ovarian cyst. The ovary is made up of three different cell types including epithelial cells, germ cells, and stromal cells. These cells can also invade or metastasize (spread) to other parts of the body. Dysgerminoma accounts for 35% of ovarian cancer in young women and is the most likely Ovarian cancer is a cancerous tumor of an ovary. Common areas to which the cancer may spread include the lining of the abdomen, lymph nodes, lungs, and liver. These symptoms may include bloating, vaginal bleeding, pelvic pain, abdominal swelling, constipation, and loss of appetite, among others. When this process begins, there may be no or only vague symptoms. When these cells become abnormal, they can divide and form tumors. It may originate from the ovary itself or more commonly from nearby structures such as fallopian tubes or the inner lining of the abdomen

The risk of ovarian cancer increases with age. Most cases of ovarian cancer develop after menopause. It is also more common in women who have ovulated more over their lifetime. This includes those who have never had children, those who began ovulation at a younger age and those who reach menopause at an older age. Other risk factors include hormone therapy after menopause, fertility... As dermoid cysts grow slowly and contain mature tissue, this type of cystic teratoma is nearly always benign. In those rare cases wherein the dermoid cyst is malignant, a squamous cell carcinoma usually develops in adults, while infants and children usually present with an endodermal sinus tumor.

Usually, these cysts spontaneously resolve after the molar pregnancy is terminated. Rarely, when the theca lutein cysts are stimulated by hormones called gonadotropins, massive ascites can result. In most cases, however, abdominal symptoms are minimal and restricted to peritoneal irritation from cyst hemorrhage. Due to the enlargement of the ovaries, there is an increased risk for torsion. Surgical intervention may be required to remove ruptured or infarcted tissue.

== Signs and symptoms ==

Endometriomas are usually benign growths, most often found in the ovary. They form dark, fluid-filled cysts, which can vary greatly in size. The fluid inside the cysts is thick, dark, old blood that resembles the color of chocolate, giving it the name chocolate cyst. It can also develop in the cul-de-sac (the space behind the uterus), the surface of the uterus, and between the vagina and rectum. Often, cysts are simply observed over time. If they cause pain, medications such as paracetamol (acetaminophen) or ibuprofen may be used. Hormonal birth control may be used to prevent further cysts in those who are frequently affected.

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However, evidence does not support birth control as a treatment of current cysts. If they do not go away after several... 593ce0642b Its rupture can create sharp, severe pain on the side of the ovary on which the cyst appears. This sharp pain (sometimes called mittelschmerz) occurs in the middle of the menstrual cycle, during ovulation. About a fourth of women with this type of cyst experience pain. If the egg fails to release from the follicle in the ovary an ovarian cyst may form. Small ovarian cysts are common in healthy women. Some women have more follicles than usual (polyendocrine metabolic ovarian syndrome), which inhibits the follicles to grow normally and this will cause cycle irregularities. 593ce0642b More broadly, endometriosis is the presence of tissue similar to, but distinct from, endometrial tissue located outside the uterus. The presence of endometriosis can result in the formation of scar tissue, adhesions and an inflammatory reaction. 593ce0642b

Ovarian torsion Complications may include infection, bleeding, or infertility. Risk factors include ovarian cysts, ovarian enlargement, ovarian tumors, pregnancy, fertility treatment, and prior tubal ligation. Symptoms typically include pelvic pain on one side. infertility. The diagnosis Ovarian torsion (OT) or adnexal torsion is an abnormal condition where an ovary twists on its attachment to other structures, such that blood flow is decreased. Other symptoms may include nausea. While classically the pain is sudden in onset, this is not always the case 593ce0642b
