It consists of two types of molecules: the linear and helical amylose and the branched amylopectin. Depending on the plant, starch generally contains 20–25% amylose and 75–80% amylopectin by weight. glycol, glycerol and sugar alcohols, may have a sweet taste, but are not classified as sugar.
