

Gas And Natural Gas

The natural-gas condensate is also called condensate, or gas condensate, or sometimes natural gasoline because it contains hydrocarbons within the gasoline boiling range, and is also referred to by the shortened name *condy* by many workers on gas installations. The natural gas is then condensed into a liquid at close to atmospheric pressure by cooling it to approximately $-162\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$ ($-260\text{ }^{\circ}\text{F}$); maximum transport pressure is set at around 127 kPa (18 psi), which is approximately 1.25 times atmospheric pressure at sea level. The gas stream is typically separated into the liquefied petroleum fractions (butane and propane) and the lighter ethane and methane fractions. These lighter fractions of methane and ethane make up the bulk of LNG that is liquefied and stored...

Natural gas is a fossil fuel that is formed when layers of organic matter (primarily marine microorganisms) are thermally decomposed under oxygen-free conditions, subjected to intense heat and pressure underground over millions of years. The energy that the decayed organisms originally obtained from the sun via photosynthesis is stored as chemical energy within the molecules of methane and other hydrocarbons. Most natural gas is collected from underground geological formations, often alongside other fossil fuels like coal and oil (petroleum). Natural gas is often a... Ukraine has the largest gas storage in Europe. In 2012, Naftogaz and China Development Bank signed a deal to switch power and chemical production plants from natural gas to coal gasification technologies. SNG in the form of liquefied natural gas (LNG) or compressed natural gas (CNG) can be used in road, rail, air and marine transport vehicles as a substitute for costly fuels like diesel and petrol. The carbon footprint of SNG derived from coal is comparable to that of petroleum products. Bio-SNG has a much smaller carbon footprint compared to petroleum products. Liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) can also be produced by synthesising SNG with partial reverse hydrogenation at high pressure and low temperature. LPG is more easily transportable than SNG, more suitable as fuel in two-wheeler or smaller horsepower vehicles and engines, and also fetches higher price in international markets due to short supply. Raw natural gas comes primarily from three types of wells: crude oil wells, gas wells, and condensate wells. Crude oil and natural gas are often found together in the same reservoir. Natural gas produced in wells with crude oil is generally classified as associated-dissolved gas as the gas had been associated with or dissolved in crude oil. Natural gas production not associated with crude oil is classified as "non-associated". In 2009, 89 percent of U.S. wellhead production of natural gas was non-associated. Russia's pipeline exports contracted significantly due to the Russo-Ukrainian war, with Gazprom's exports falling from 185 billion cubic meters in 2021 to around 100 billion in 2022. Russia has since redirected portions of its energy exports to Asia; however, increased natural gas sales to countries like China and India have not fully offset the severe financial and structural revenue losses. This decline was driven by an energy dispute where Russia cut off supplies to countries that did not comply with its payment demands in rubles, coupled with the sabotage of the Nord Stream pipelines.
