Bench press Other muscles located in the back, legs and core are involved for stabilization. The bench press is a compound movement, with the primary muscles involved being the pectoralis major, the anterior deltoids, and the triceps brachii. A barbell is generally used to hold the weight, but a pair of dumbbells can also be used. bench with a barbell grasped in both hands. Flies can be performed using any weight that can be held in the hand. The simplest equipment to use is a dumbbell, though the exercise can also be performed using a cable machine. The pectoralis major's primary functions are flexion, adduction, and internal rotation of the humerus. == Movement == a36fcc66f1 The standard pull-down motion is a compound movement that requires dynamic work by muscles surrounding the three joints which move during the exercise. These are the elbow in conjunction with the glenohumeral and scapulothoracic joints in the shoulder girdle. a36fcc66f1

Pull-down (exercise) The pec minor also works in conjunction with the rhomboid The pull-down exercise is a strength training exercise designed to develop the latissimus dorsi muscle.
