Progesterone is a naturally occurring and bioidentical progestogen, or an agonist of the progesterone receptor, the biological target of progestogens like endogenous progesterone. Progesterone also has antimineralocorticoid and inhibitory neurosteroid activity, whereas it appears to have little or no glucocorticoid or antiandrogenic activity and has no androgenic activity. Because of its progestogenic activity, progesterone has functional antiestrogenic effects in certain tissues such as the uterus, cervix, and vagina. In addition, progesterone has antigonadotropic effects due to its progestogenic activity and can inhibit fertility and suppress sex hormone production. Progesterone differs from progestins (synthetic progestogens) like medroxyprogesterone acetate and norethisterone, with implications for pharmacodynamics and pharmacokinetics as well as efficacy, tolerability, and safety.

Common sites for intramuscular injections include the deltoid muscle of the upper arm and the gluteal muscle of the buttock. In infants, the vastus lateralis muscle of the thigh is commonly used. The injection site must be cleaned before administering the injection, and the injection is then administered in a fast, darting motion to decrease the discomfort to the individual. The volume to be injected in the muscle is usually limited to 2–5 milliliters, depending on injection site. A site with signs of infection or muscle atrophy should not be chosen. Intramuscular injections should not be used in people with myopathies or those with trouble clotting.

Nandrolone decanoate Like testosterone Nandrolone decanoate, sold under the brand names Rolon and Deca-Durabolin, among others, is an androgen and anabolic steroid (AAS) medication which is used primarily in the treatment of anemias and wasting syndromes, as well as osteoporosis in menopausal women. with intramuscular injection and varies with the site of injection, with the highest bioavailability seen when injected into the gluteal muscle. Paliperidone palmitate It is an antipsychotic ester – specifically the palmitate ester of paliperidone – and acts as a long-lasting form of paliperidone. A formulation for injection once every Paliperidone palmitate (PP), sold under the brand names Invega Sustenna, Xeplion, Shansida (Chinese: 尚思达), Erzofri and Psokadron for the once-monthly formulation, and as Invega Trinza/Trevicta (three-monthly) and Invega Hafyera/Byannli (six-monthly), is a long-acting injectable atypical antipsychotic of the benzisoxazole class, used in the treatment of schizophrenia and schizoaffective disorder. Paliperidone palmitate is formulated as an aqueous suspension, has a strong smell similar to alcohol, and is administered by intramuscular injection into deltoid or gluteal muscle once every 1, 3, or 6 months depending on the formulation. Intramuscular injection Intramuscular injection may be preferred because muscles have larger and more numerous blood vessels than subcutaneous tissue, leading to faster absorption than subcutaneous or intradermal injections. In infants Intramuscular injection, often abbreviated IM, is the injection of a substance into a muscle. Medication administered via intramuscular injection is not subject to the first-pass metabolism effect which affects oral medications. In medicine, it is one of several methods for parenteral administration of medications. affects oral medications.
