Upper airway resistance syndrome The symptoms include snoring, unrefreshing sleep, nocturia, fatigue, sleepiness, chronic insomnia, and difficulty concentrating. It can be treated with lifestyle changes, functional orthodontics, surgery, mandibular repositioning devices or CPAP therapy. Patients may have other anatomical abnormalities that can cause UARS such as deviated septum, inferior Upper airway resistance syndrome (UARS) is a sleep disorder characterized by the narrowing of the airway that can cause disruptions to sleep. the nasal airway and behind the base of the tongue. UARS can be diagnosed by polysomnograms capable of detecting Respiratory Effort-related Arousals. Nasal cartilages There are five individual cartilages that make up the nasal cavity: septal nasal cartilage, lateral nasal cartilage, major alar cartilage (greater alar cartilage, or cartilage of the aperture), minor alar cartilage (lesser alar cartilage, sesamoid, or accessory cartilage), and vomeronasal cartilage (Jacobson's cartilage). changes due to moderate cases of a deviated septum. Nasal valve collapse Obstruction through the nasal valves can be classified as static or dynamic. Management can include conservative treatment, but most patients are referred for surgery. Dynamic obstruction is the collapse of a weak nasal valve due to pressure differences. Dynamic obstruction typically occurs when the external nasal valve is flexible or Nasal valve collapse is a condition where airflow through the nose is restricted due to the narrowing or collapse of the nasal valves. abnormalities such as a deviated septum or scarring from previous surgery.
