She became one of the first female city councillors of Madrid in 1924. In 1927 she became one of the 13 women represented in the National Assembly of the dictatorship of Primo de Rivera, in office from 10 October 1927 to 15 February 1930. She died in San Sebastián in 1955. aa68488f50 In 2011 she was selected along with Michelle Obama as one of the most important women of the year by Siempre Mujer magazine.
