A chloroplast (KLOR-ə-plast, -plahst) is a type of organelle known as a plastid that conducts photosynthesis mostly in plant and algal cells. The chemical energy created is then used to make sugar and other organic molecules from carbon dioxide in the Calvin cycle. Chloroplasts are highly dynamic - they circulate and are moved around within cells. Their behavior is strongly influenced by environmental factors, such as light color and intensity. Chloroplasts cannot be made anew by the plant cell and must be inherited by each daughter cell during cell division, which is thought to be inherited from their ancestor—an ancient photosynthetic cyanobacterium that was engulfed by an early eukaryotic cell. Cellular differentiation Thus, different cells can have very different physical. Usually, the cell changes to a more specialized type. These changes are largely due to highly controlled modifications in gene expression and are the study of epigenetics. organism is known as pluripotent. With a few exceptions, cellular differentiation almost never involves a change in the DNA sequence itself. Metabolic composition, however, gets dramatically altered where stem cells are characterized by abundant metabolites with highly unsaturated structures whose levels decrease upon differentiation. Differentiation happens multiple times during the development of a multicellular organism as it changes from a simple zygote to a complex system of tissues and cell types. Such cells are called meristematic cells in higher plants and embryonic stem cells in animals, though some groups report Cellular differentiation, also known as cellular specification, is the process in which a stem cell changes from one type to a differentiated one. Differentiation continues in adulthood as adult stem cells divide and create fully differentiated daughter cells during tissue repair and during normal cell turnover. Differentiation dramatically changes a cell's size, shape, membrane potential, metabolic activity, and responsiveness to signals. Some differentiation occurs in response to antigen exposure

Phloem In an adult, the phloem originates, and grows outwards from, meristematic cells in the vascular Phloem (, FLOH-əm) is the living tissue in vascular plants that transports the soluble organic compounds made during photosynthesis and known as photosynthates, in particular the sugar sucrose, to the rest of the plant. Different types of phloem can be distinguished. This transport process is called translocation. The early phloem formed in the growth apices is called protophloem. Protophloem eventually becomes obliterated once it connects to the durable phloem in mature organs, the metaphloem.
