Rainbow flag (LGBTQ) The colors reflect The rainbow flag or pride flag (formerly gay pride flag) is a symbol of LGBTQ pride and LGBTQ social movements, as well as a peace symbol. Using a rainbow flag as a symbol of LGBTQ pride began in San Francisco, California, and subsequently became common at LGBTQ rights events worldwide. The colors reflect the diversity of

Contemporary international uses of a rainbow flag dates to the beginning of the 20th century. The International Co-operative Alliance adopted a rainbow flag in 1925. A similar flag (ca. 1920) is used in Andean indigenism in Peru and Bolivia to represent the legacy of the Inca Empire. Since 1961, the international peace flag, also known as the PACE flag, has been especially popular in Italy and to a lesser extent Europe and the rest of the world. Since 1978, when it was created to represent gay pride, the rainbow pride flag has evolved as a symbol of the LGBT movement (in 1978, the community as a whole was referred to and described as the "Gay" community; the term "LGBT" did not yet exist.) 0b914eae9c Rainbows when viewed from the ground typically appear as an illuminated arc, but when flying, if there is enough mist they can be seen as full circles. The centre of the curve is always on a line from the Sun to the observer's eye.

There are several independent rainbow flags in use today. In the 18th century, American Revolutionary War writer Thomas Paine proposed that a rainbow flag be used as a maritime flag to signify neutral ships in time of war.

Rainbow capitalism (also called pink capitalism, queer capitalism, homocapitalism or gay capitalism) is the involvement of capitalism, corporate capitalism, and consumerism in participating in, appropriating, and profiting from the LGBTQ movement. It developed as the LGBTQ community became more accepted in society and developed sufficient purchasing power to be a viable market,

known as pink money. Early rainbow capitalism, during the 20th century, was limited to gay bars and gay bathhouses, though it had expanded to most industries in many Western countries by the early-21st century
