Sporotrichosis It Sporotrichosis, also known as rose handler's disease, is a fungal infection that may be localised to skin, lungs, bone and joint, or become systemic. Following initial exposure to *Sporothrix schenckii*, the disease typically progresses over a period of a week to several months. It presents with firm painless nodules that later ulcerate. This candidal carriage state is not considered a disease, but when *Candida* species become pathogenic and invade host tissues, oral candidiasis can occur. Fungi, like animals, are heterotrophs: they acquire their nutrition by absorbing dissolved organic molecules, typically by secreting digestive enzymes into their environment. A fungus does not perform photosynthesis. Growth is their means of motility, except for spores (a few of which are flagellated), which may travel through the air or water. Fungi

are the principal decomposers in ecological systems. These and other differences place fungi in a single group of related organisms, named the Eumycota (true fungi or Eumycetes), that share a common ancestor (i.e. they form a monophyletic group), an interpretation that is also strongly supported by molecular phylogenetics. This fungal group is distinct from the structurally similar myxomycetes (slime molds) and oomycetes (water molds). The antifungal medication terbinafine taken by mouth appears to be the most effective but is associated with liver problems. The condition returns in up to half of cases following treatment. Urinary tract infection Symptoms may be less clear in very young or old people. Symptoms from a lower UTI include burning or pain during urination, pain in the lower abdomen and the urge to urinate even when the bladder is empty. Lower UTIs affect the bladder (cystitis) or urethra while upper UTIs affect the kidney (pyelonephritis). Risk of infections increases as males age. The genus *Candida* encompasses about 200 species. Many species are harmless commensals or endosymbionts of hosts including humans. When mucosal barriers are disrupted or the immune system is compromised, however, they can invade and cause disease, known as an opportunistic infection. *Candida* is located on most mucosal surfaces and mainly the gastrointestinal tract, along with the skin. *Candida albicans* is one of the most commonly isolated species and can cause infections (candidiasis or thrush) in humans and other animals. 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The genome of several *Candida* species has been sequenced. 3aa8e78d2b Most cases are caused by *Hortaea werneckii*, a pigmented fungus, which is a dark yeast found in sewage, soil, rotting vegetation and wood and in places with a high salt content such as moldy salted fish and on beaches, where contact with sand may result in transmission. Infection is by direct contact and the fungus enters and remains in the outer dead layer of skin with little or no skin inflammation. The infection does not invade deeper tissues. 3aa8e78d2b Treatment depends on the site and extent of infection. Topical antifungals may be applied to skin lesions. Deep infection in the lungs may require surgery. Systemic medications used include Itraconazole, posaconazole and amphotericin B. With treatment, most people will recover, but an immunocompromised... 3aa8e78d2b It is sometimes equated with dermatophytosis, and, while most conditions identified as

Sporotrichosis is caused by fungi of the *S. schenckii* species complex. Because *S. schenckii* is naturally found in soil, hay, sphagnum moss, and plants, it most often affects farmers, gardeners, and agricultural workers. It enters through small cuts in the skin to cause a fungal infection. In cases of sporotrichosis affecting the lungs, the fungal spores enter by inhalation. Risk factors include being female, sexual intercourse, diabetes, using a catheter, and family history. Additional factors that have been found to increase the risk of infection include urinary retention (delaying urination), insufficient water intake, use of spermicides as a contraceptive method, and poor genital hygiene. 3aa8e78d2b The most common causative organism is *Trichophyton rubrum*. The condition is more likely to occur in people who sweat more. Diagnosis is by visualization, microscopy and culture. It may appear similar to dermatitis, psoriasis, keratoderma, hyperkeratosis and allergic contact dermatitis. Treatment is with long-term systemic antifungals, typically oral terbinafine or itraconazole. 3aa8e78d2b A number of different types of fungus can cause onychomycosis, including dermatophytes and *Fusarium*. Risk factors include athlete's

foot, other nail diseases, exposure to someone with the condition, peripheral vascular disease, and poor immune function. The diagnosis is generally suspected based on the appearance and confirmed by laboratory testing. 3aa8e78d2b

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
