Languages of Fiji While the 1997 constitution declared English, Fijian and Hindustani as official languages of the state, the 2013 constitution does not explicitly establish one. The primary language of the Fijian Government Fiji has four primary national languages: English, Fijian (iTaukei), Standard Hindi (Hindustani), and Fiji Hindi. The three-year-long agitation was multifaceted and involved fasts, conferences, marches, picketing and protests. Government crackdown resulted in the deaths of two protesters and the arrests of 1,198 persons (including women and children). After

the government resigned in 1939, the mandatory Hindi education was withdrawn in 1940.
