Barrier creams that contain petroleum jelly or certain oils may cause rubber or latex A barrier cream is a topical formulation used in industrial applications and as a cosmetic to place a physical barrier between the skin and contaminants that may irritate the skin (contact dermatitis or occupational dermatitis). For hand care they are designed to protect against the harm from detergents and other irritants. Three classes of barrier creams are used: water repellent creams, water-soluble creams, and creams designed for special applications. There are many other terms for creams designed to protect skin from harmful substances, including skin protective creams, pre-work creams, antisolvent gels, protective ointments, and shielding lotions 5113210221

In the United States, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) oversees the National Organic Program (NOP) with strict requirements across ingredient sourcing, production, handling, and documentation; and governs organic claim eligibility. Instead, the fish accumulate the acids by consuming either microalgae or prey fish that have accumulated omega-3 fatty acids. Fatty predatory fish, like sharks, swordfish, tilefish, and albacore tuna, may be high in omega-3 fatty acids, but due to their position at the top of the food chain, these species may also accumulate toxic substances through biomagnification. For this reason, the United States Environmental Protection Agency recommends limiting consumption (especially for women of childbearing age) of certain (predatory) fish species (e.g., albacore tuna, shark, king mackerel, tilefish and swordfish) due to high levels of the toxic contaminant... 5113210221 Many of them are bacteria of which there are around 1,000 species upon human skin from nineteen phyla.
