Iron It is the fourth most abundant element in the Earth’s crust. It is, by mass, the most common element on Earth, forming much of Earth’s outer and inner core

Snowball Earth insoluble in water. The banded iron formations are commonly very old and their deposition is often related to the oxidation of Earth’s atmosphere during the Palaeoproterozoic

Much of the past work on measuring the isotopic composition of iron has centered on determining ⁶⁰Fe variations due to processes accompanying nucleosynthesis (e.g., meteorite studies) and ore formation. In the last decade however, advances in mass spectrometry technology have allowed the detection and quantification of minute, naturally occurring variations in the ratios of the stable isotopes of iron. Much of this work has been driven by the Earth and planetary science communities, though applications to biological and industrial systems are beginning to emerge.
