Along with other antibiotics it may be used to treat tuberculosis, meningitis, or pelvic inflammatory disease. It is available orally, intravenously, and in eye drop form. Levofloxacin is also used as antibiotic eye drops to prevent bacterial infection. It is the left-handed isomer of the medication ofloxacin. pylori (in combination with other medications), urinary tract infections, Legionnaires' disease, chronic bacterial prostatitis, and some types of gastroenteritis. It is used to treat a number of bacterial infections including acute bacterial sinusitis, pneumonia, H f818efed6f

Common side effects include nausea, diarrhea, and trouble sleeping. A warning concerning all fluoroquinolones was issued in 2016: "An FDA safety review has shown that fluoroquinolones when used systemically (i.e. tablets, capsules, and injectable) are associated with disabling and potentially permanent serious adverse effects that can occur together. These adverse effects can involve the tendons, muscles, joints, nerves, and central nervous system." f818efed6f

Although there are risks of infections or other complications, with suitable precautions throughout the injection process, chances for these complications could be lowered. g. It is used to treat various eye diseases, such as age-related macular degeneration (AMD), diabetic retinopathy, and infections inside the eye such as endophthalmitis. Norfloxacin is associated with a number of rare serious adverse reactions as well as spontaneous tendon ruptures and irreversible peripheral neuropathy. Other uses, along with other medications, include treating multidrug resistant tuberculosis. Uveitis The uvea consists of the middle layer of pigmented vascular structures of the eye and includes the iris, ciliary body, and choroid. Symptoms include eye pain, eye redness, floaters, and blurred vision, and ophthalmic examination may show dilated ciliary blood vessels and the presence of cells in the anterior chamber. Treatment typically involves the use of topical eye drops (steroids), intravitreal injection, newer biologics, and treating Uveitis () is inflammation of the uvea, the pigmented layer of the eye between the inner retina and the outer fibrous layer composed of the sclera and cornea. Anterior uveitis (iritidocyclitis) is the most common, with the incidence of uveitis overall affecting approximately 1:4500, most commonly those between the ages of 20 and 60. Uveitis is described anatomically, by the part of the eye affected, as anterior, intermediate, or posterior, or panuveitic if all parts are involved. Uveitis may arise spontaneously, have a genetic component, or be associated with an autoimmune disease or infection. inflammation to prevent vision loss. While the eye is a relatively protected environment, its immune mechanisms may be activated, resulting in inflammation and tissue destruction associated with T-cell activation

In the United States, moxifloxacin is licensed for the treatment of acute bacterial... Common side effects include nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea. Severe side effects include tendon rupture, hallucinations, and nerve damage. In people with myasthenia gravis, there is worsening muscle weakness. Rates of side effects appear to be higher than some groups of antibiotics such as cephalosporins but lower than others such as clindamycin. Studies in other animals raise concerns regarding use in pregnancy. No problems were identified, however, in the children of a small number of women who took the medication. It appears to be safe during breastfeeding. It is a second-generation fluoroquinolone with a broad spectrum of activity that usually results in the death of the bacteria. Moxifloxacin was patented in 1988 and approved for use in the United States in 1999. It is on the World Health Organization's List of Essential Medicines. In 2023, it was the 237th most commonly prescribed medication in the United States, with more than one million prescriptions. The initial approval by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in 1986 encompassed the following indications: It was patented in 1977 and approved for medical use in 1983.
