In 2007, he ran 13 marathons (not including ultra-marathons), and seven marathons in a span of nine weeks (winning three). The original Japanese term referred to the age old post-horse or stagecoach courier system which transmitted communication by stages. Instead of one horse or a man covering the entire long distance a relay team of multiple horses or runners would be employed. Eki means "station" and den translates as "to communicate, to convey", therefore ekiden could be roughly translated as "Station to station". The original meaning of the word is reflected in its rule where each runner at the end of their run has to pass down their sash to the next runner. Today ekiden is a national sport in Japan, especially popular as inter-varsity competitions between schools or universities, and its popularity has since become widespread and worldwide. Running on the road is an alternative surface to running on a trail, track, or treadmill. For many people looking to participate in running as an activity or sport, there are multiple opportunities that can be found on the road. == Course == The one mile run was a common athletic event in 18th and 19th century England, primarily for gambling purposes. It survived track and field's switch to metric distances in the 1900s and retained its popularity, with the chase for the four-minute mile in the 1950s a high point for the race. Each year, the Bellin Run releases a custom logo to commemorate

that race. The "South" (running down) Peachtree was founded in 1970 and has been the world's largest 10k race since the late 1970s. The race has become a citywide tradition in which over 70,000 amateur and professional runners try to register for one of the limited 60,000 spots. The event also includes a wheelchair race (known as the Shepherd Center wheelchair division), which precedes the footrace. In recent years, the race also has a special division for soldiers stationed in the Middle East. The race attracts some of the world's elite 10K runners and has served as both the United States' men's and women's 10K championship. Race courses are usually held on the streets of major cities and towns but can be on any road. World Athletics recognizes eleven common distances for road... In spite of the roughly equivalent 1500 metres race, which is used instead of the mile at the World Championships and Olympic Games and is sometimes referred as the foremost middle-distance track event in athletics, the mile run is present in all fields of athletics. Since 1976, it is the only imperial distance World Athletics has on its books for official world records. Spartan Race acquired Tough Mudder, which had been forced into involuntary bankruptcy proceedings, in February 2020. Spartan Race purchased Tough Mudder assets for \$700,000 and the assumption of debts, including honoring prepaid tickets, which was approved by the bankruptcy court for the District of Delaware. As of January 2024, 19 Tough Mudder events were scheduled for the remainder of the year in the United States and Canada. The first ever ekiden as a sport was held in Japan in 1917 as a 3-day, 23-stage run from Kyoto to Tokyo over 507 kilometres (315 mi), to celebrate the 50th anniversary of Tokyo's establishment as the nation's capital (previously Kyoto was the imperial seat). == Early life and education ==
