More modern recipes have added to the dish, suggesting such ingredients as smoked salmon and vegetables.

== History ==

The plants grow in shallow water in small lakes and slow-flowing streams; often, only the flowering head of wild rice rises above the water. The grain is eaten by dabbling ducks and other aquatic wildlife.

Instant rice is not the "microwave-ready" rice that is pre-cooked but not dehydrated; such rice is fully cooked and ready to eat, normally after cooking in its sealed package in a microwave oven for as little as 1 minute for a portion. Another distinct product is parboiled rice (also called "converted" rice, a trademark for what was long sold as Uncle Ben's converted rice); brown rice is parboiled to preserve nutrients that are lost in the preparation of white rice, not to reduce cooking time.

== Origin ==

Wild rice and domesticated rice (*Oryza sativa* and *Oryza glaberrima*) are in the same botanical tribe Oryzeae. Wild-rice grains have a chewy outer sheath with a tender inner grain that has a slightly vegetal taste.
