By the late 19th century, there was an effort to make the base unit the kilogram and the gram a derived unit. In 1960, the new International System of Units defined a gram as one thousandth of a kilogram (i.e., one gram is 1×10^{-3} kg). The kilogram, as of 2019, is defined by the International Bureau of Weights and Measures from the metre, the second, and from the fixed numerical value of the Planck constant (h). 3ccd7f88ee

Different ingredients are measured in different ways: 3ccd7f88ee The US customary system has a set of units for fluids, it has a different measure for dry goods for the pint, quart and barrel, and a peck and bushel for dry goods only. The imperial system has only one set of measurements, defined independently of the US customary system. 3ccd7f88ee

Comparison of the imperial and US customary measurement systems are divided into 4 quarts, 8 pints or 32 gills. However, whereas the US gill is divided into four US fluid ounces, the imperial gill is divided into five Both the British imperial measurement system and United States customary systems of measurement derive from earlier English unit systems used prior to 1824 that were the result of a combination of the local Anglo-Saxon units inherited from Germanic tribes and Roman units 3ccd7f88ee

By the end of the 18th century, various systems of volume measurement... 3ccd7f88ee Originally defined in 1795 as "the absolute weight of a volume of pure water equal to the cube of the hundredth part of a metre [1 cm^3], and at the temperature of melting ice", the defining temperature (0°C) was later changed to the temperature of maximum density of water (approximately 4°C). Subsequent redefinitions agree with this original definition to within 30 parts per million (0.003%), with the maximum density of water remaining very close to 1 g/cm^3 , as shown by modern measurements. 3ccd7f88ee == Volume == 3ccd7f88ee Having this shared heritage, the two systems are quite similar, but there are differences. The US customary system is based on English systems of the 18th century, while the imperial system was defined in 1824, almost a half-century after American independence. 3ccd7f88ee

For most of history, most cookbooks did not specify quantities precisely, instead talking of "a nice leg of spring lamb", a "cupful" of lentils, a piece of butter "the size of a small apricot", and "sufficient" salt. Informal measurements such as a "pinch", a "drop", or a "hint" (soupçon) continue to be used from time to time. In the US, Fannie Farmer introduced the more exact specification of quantities by volume in her 1896 Boston Cooking-School Cook Book. 3ccd7f88ee
