considered to be dangerously toxic. There are sensationalised news reports regarding Australian spiders that fail to cite evidence. A Field Guide to Spiders of Australia published by CSIRO Publishing in 2017 featuring around 836 species illustrated with photographs of live animals, around 381 genera and 78 families, introduced significant updates to taxonomy from Ramirez, Wheeler and Dmitrov.

== Taxonomy and nomenclature == This spider species is considered beneficial in parts of the world because it preys on other spiders, including species considered dangerous such as redback spiders. List of medically significant spider bites Two medically important spider genera have a worldwide distribution—*Latrodectus* and *Loxosceles*. The term “daddy-long-legs” also can refer to the similar-looking *Pholcus*. A number of spiders can cause spider bites that are medically important. Almost all spiders produce venom but only a few are able to cause significant harm to humans. Others have a limited distribution. Biting people are rare, and no reported bites by these species have had any lasting effects 4903dc454d

Pholcids have extremely long and thin legs with flexible tarsi. They can be distinguished from other long-legged spiders by the eye arrangement: Pholcidae have two groups of three eyes each, and there may be a pair of small eyes in between them. Most have this middle pair present for a total of eight eyes, but some genera (e.g. *Modisimus*, *Spermophora*, *Spermophorides*) lack this pair and have a total of six eyes. The body is often whitish or grey in colour.
