

Can Eggs Cause Constipation

Human feces have similarities to the feces of other animals and varies significantly in appearance (i.e. size, color, texture), according to the state of the diet, digestive system, and general health. Normally, human feces are semisolid, with a mucus coating. Small pieces of harder, less moist feces can sometimes be seen impacted in the distal (final or lower) end. This is a normal occurrence when a prior bowel movement is incomplete, and feces are returned from the rectum to the large intestine, where water is further absorbed. b7d43d2736

Taenia saginata Thus, reproduction is by self-fertilisation. From humans, embryonated eggs, called oncospheres, are released with faeces and are transmitted to cattle through contaminated fodder. It is relatively common in Africa, Europe, Southeast Asia, South Asia, and Latin America. Oncospheres *Taenia saginata* (synonym *Taeniarhynchus saginatus*), commonly known as the beef tapeworm, is a zoonotic tapeworm belonging to the order Cyclophyllidea and genus *Taenia*. It is an intestinal parasite in humans causing taeniasis (a type of helminthiasis) and cysticercosis in cattle. the uterus contains up to 15 side branches filled with eggs. Humans are generally infected as a result of eating raw or undercooked beef which contains the infective larvae, called cysticerci. It is found globally and most prevalently where cattle are raised and beef is consumed. Cattle acquire the embryonated eggs, the oncospheres, when they eat contaminated food. Cattle are the intermediate hosts, where larval development occurs, while humans are definitive hosts harbouring the adult worms. As hermaphrodites, each body segment called proglottid has complete sets of both male and female reproductive systems. Oncospheres develop inside muscle, liver, and lungs of cattle into infective cysticerci b7d43d2736

Pruritus ani At worst, anal itching causes intolerable discomfort accompanied by burning and soreness. irritation and trauma to the perianal area. If this is not effective topical steroids or injected methylene blue *Pruritus ani* is the irritation of the skin at the exit of the rectum, known as the anus, causing the desire to scratch. It is estimated that up to 5% of the population of the United States experiences this type of discomfort daily. In severe cases, additional antibiotics may be needed. The most effective prevention is via vaccination, especially important for cattle. b7d43d2736 Prevention is by properly cooking meat. Treatment is generally with praziquantel, though niclosamide may also be used. Together with cysticercosis, infections affect about 50 million people globally. The disease is most common in the developing world. In the United States fewer than 1,000 cases occur annually. b7d43d2736

Pterophyllum This body shape allows them to hide among roots and plants, often on a vertical surface. Eggs are generally laid on a submerged log or a flattened leaf but can also be laid on filter piping when kept in an aquarium setting. As is the case for other cichlids, brood care is highly developed. All *Pterophyllum* species originate in the Amazon Basin, Orinoco Basin and various rivers in the Guiana Shield in tropical South America. Naturally occurring angelfish are frequently striped transversely, colouration which provides additional camouflage. Tipper served for many years in the West African Medical Service. He authored *The Cradle of the World and Cancer*, in 1927. The book was based on his twenty years of medical practice in Nigeria. He examined only six cases of cancer out of an estimated 300,000 patients. The Nigerian diet was low in meat and high in fibre which is opposite to the European diet. Tipper came to the conclusion that constipation and excessive meat-eating were the causes of cancer. b7d43d2736 If a specific cause for pruritus ani is found it is classified as "secondary pruritus ani". If a specific cause is not found it is classified as "idiopathic pruritus ani". The irritation can be caused by intestinal parasites, anal perspiration, frequent liquid stools, diarrhea, residual stool deposits, or the escape of small amounts of stool as a result of incontinence or flatulence. Another cause is yeast infection or candidiasis. Some diseases increase the possibility of yeast

infections, such as diabetes mellitus or HIV infection. Treatment with antibiotics can bring about a disturbance of the natural balance of intestinal flora, and lead to perianal thrush, a yeast infection affecting the anus. There are generally no or only mild symptoms. Complications of pork tapeworm may include cysticercosis. Segments of tapeworm may be seen in the stool. infection causes weight loss, dizziness, abdominal pain, diarrhea, headaches, nausea, constipation, chronic indigestion, and loss of appetite b7d43d2736

According to Tipper the Béné tribe, who live in the Niger Delta amongst whom he practised for twenty years, are almost free from cancer and live on a semi-vegetarian diet. Diphyllobothriasis mostly occurs in regions where raw fish is regularly consumed; those who consume raw fish are at risk of infection. The infection is often asymptomatic and usually presents only with mild symptoms, which may include gastrointestinal complaints, weight loss, and fatigue. Rarely, vitamin B12 deficiency (possibly leading to anaemia) and gastrointestinal obstructions may occur. Infection may be long-lasting in absence of treatment. Diphyllobothriasis is generally diagnosed by looking for eggs or tapeworm segments in passed stool. Treatment with antiparasitic medications is straightforward, effective, and safe. b7d43d2736

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
