Camargue equitation 7d557fc5ba Frankie was born at Paradise Park Wildlife Sanctuary in Hayle, Cornwall, in on 1 July 2025. Her right wing was clipped shortly after her birth. She was the second flamingo born at the zoo, where she was raised by her parents in a walled garden. 7d557fc5ba The park protects a wetland environment and an adjacent marine area. The boundaries of the park have been expanded to include a lagoon called the Étang de Vaccarès. 7d557fc5ba == Regional natural parks == 7d557fc5ba Administratively, it lies within the department of Bouches-du-Rhône ('Mouths of the Rhône'); it spans portions of the communes of Arles, Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer and Port-Saint-Louis-du-Rhône. A further expanse of marshy plain, known as the "Petite Camargue" (Little Camargue; Occitan: Pichon Camarga), just to the west

of the "Petit Rhône", lies within the department of Gard. In total 60 PNRs have been created, of which one subsequently lost its status and one was renamed. They are listed here in the chronological order of creation.

He also co-founded the Rencontres d'Arles and the Parc naturel régional de Camargue.
