Shaknovsky proceeded with the operation despite concerns from the staff he was not skilled in it and that the hospital's facilities were not sufficient, and then completely botched the operation - abandoning a laparoscopic approach for an open-air one, and then removing the wrong organ, the liver, which looks nothing like a spleen and weighs ten... 60a468285a Unlike the circulatory system, which is a closed system, the lymphatic system is open. Lymph originates in the interstitial fluid that leaks from blood in the circulatory system into the tissues of the body. This fluid carries nutrients to the cells and collects waste products, bacteria, and damaged cells, before draining into the lymphatic vessels as lymph. litres (5.3 US gal) of blood per day through capillary filtration, which removes plasma from the blood. Roughly 17 litres (4.5 US gal) of the filtered blood is reabsorbed directly into the blood vessels, while the remaining 3 litres (0.79 US gal) are left in the interstitial fluid. The lymphatic system provides an accessory return route to the blood for this remainder. 60a468285a As a potential space, the recess is not normally filled with fluid. However, intra-abdominal fluid (e.g. blood or pus) can accumulate here in circumstances where the abdomen fills with fluid, such as hemoperitoneum or splenic laceration. This fluid may be detected via ultrasound sonography when the patient is lying on their back, similar to the hepatorenal recess (Morison's pouch), which is located on the right side between the right kidney and liver. Like Morison's pouch, Koller's pouch is part of the Focused Assessment with Sonography for Trauma (FAST) exam in emergency medicine. 60a468285a

Splenectomy The spleen is an important organ regarding immunological function A splenectomy is the surgical procedure that partially or completely removes the spleen. Therefore, removal of the spleen runs the risk of overwhelming post-splenectomy infection, a medical emergency and rapidly fatal disease caused by the inability of the body's immune system to properly fight infection following splenectomy or asplenia. The spleen is an important organ regarding immunological function due to its ability to efficiently destroy encapsulated bacteria. A

The stomach sits on the left side, which is attached to the esophagus tube. Food comes through the esophagus, goes behind all of the other organs in the thoracic cavity, and comes out through the point where the esophagus opens up into the stomach. The stomach is a more acidic environment to aid its role in beginning the major processes of digestion. The family farm was located north of Lloydminster, in Alberta; the eastern margin of the farm was the Alberta-Saskatchewan boundary. 60a468285a There are many diseases and disorders associated with the organs of the abdominopelvic cavity. 60a468285a "Reticuloendothelial system" is an older term for the mononuclear phagocyte system, but it is used less commonly now, as it is understood that most endothelial cells are not macrophages. 60a468285a During breathing, the diaphragm contracts and flattens, displacing the viscera and producing an outward movement of the upper abdominal wall (epigastric region). It is a convergence of the diaphragm and the abdominals, so that "when both sets of muscles (diaphragm and abdominals) tense, the epigastrium pushes forward".
