Multiple studies have been performed concerning the safety of home births for both the child and the mother. Standard practices, licensing requirements and access to emergency hospital care differ between regions making it difficult to compare studies across national borders. A 2014 US survey of medical studies found that perinatal mortality rates were triple that of hospital births, and a US nationwide study of over 13 million births on a 3-year span (2007–2010) found that births at home were roughly 10 times as likely to be stillborn (14 times in first-born babies) and almost four times as likely to have neonatal seizures or serious neurological dysfunction when compared to babies born in hospitals. Campaigners have worked tirelessly towards recognition of and apology for these injustices with varying results. There have been government apologies in Australia, Ireland and other nations such as Scotland and Wales, but many countries have failed to implement the redress and reparation measures needed to mitigate the lifelong impact on the mothers and on adult adoptees who were taken from their mothers in infancy.
