It is recommended that the minimum size for a hamster cage is at least 110 cm x 50 cm x 50 cm tall for Syrian Hamsters and 100 cm x 50 cm x 50 cm tall for dwarf species of hamsters (approximately 775 square inches of floor space). In 2014 in the United States, animal research used about 120,000 hamsters, which was 14.6% of the total research animal use (under the Animal Welfare Act which excludes mice, rats, and fish) for that year in that country. In the wild, they originate from the wheat fields of Kazakhstan, the meadows of Mongolia and Siberia, and the birch stands of Manchuria.
