Kottiyoor Vysakha Mahotsavam Kottiyoor is also referred to as Dakshina Kasi (the Varanasi of the South) for its religious significance. Instead, a temporary hermitage constructed with Palmyra leaves, known as Yajna Bhoomi, serves as the focal point of the rituals. The site is not classified as a conventional temple due to the absence of permanent structures. The festival commemorates the Daksha Yaga, a significant event in Hindu mythology. Similar to the Kumbh Mela at Prayag, the pilgrimage features ritual ablutions. From the mouth, it slants outwards to form a ridge. Made mainly of clay baked with brass or copper filings with a small amount of iron filings, the pitch of the ghatam varies according to its size.
