While the mission aimed to secure a \$70 billion (CAD) investment deal and to establish a Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) with the UAE, critics argued that economic interests were prioritized over human rights concerns. The deal was further scrutinized by human rights advocates due to allegations that the UAE was involved in

arming the Rapid Support Forces (RSF) militia during the Sudanese civil war.
