Satpura Tiger Reserve is named after the Satpura Range. Satpura is a Sanskrit word, that means seven mountains (sapta – seven and pura – mountain). The area was first explored by Captain James Forsyth in 1862, while he was searching for the Indian freedom fighter Tatya Tope. It is one of the first declared Reserved Forest Areas of India due to its ecological and commercial importance. It became a tiger reserve in 2000. Technically, the Vindhyas do not form a single mountain range in the geological sense. The exact extent of the Vindhyas is loosely defined, and historically, the term covered a number of distinct hill systems in central India, including the

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one that is now known as the Satpura Range. Today, the term principally refers to the escarpment and its hilly extensions that runs north of and roughly parallel to the Narmada River in Madhya Pradesh. Depending on the definition, the range extends up to Gujarat in the west, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar in the north, and Chhattisgarh in the east. The average elevation of the Vindhyas is also dependent on different sources. 0c5a5ae4

There are numerous short coastal rivers, predominantly on the West coast. The rivers of India can be classified into four groups – Himalayan, Deccan, Coastal, and Inland drainage. The

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Deccan rivers system consists of rivers in Peninsular India, that drain into the Bay of Bengal and the Arabian Sea

On the south, India projects into and is bounded by the Indian Ocean—in particular, by the Arabian Sea on the west, the Lakshadweep Sea to the southwest, the Bay of Bengal on the east, and the Indian Ocean proper to the south. The Palk Strait and Gulf of Mannar separate India from Sri Lanka to its immediate southeast, and the Maldives are some 125 kilometres (78 mi) to the south of India's Lakshadweep Islands across the Eight Degree Channel. India's Andaman and Nicobar Islands, some 1,200 kilometres (750 mi) southeast of the mainland, share maritime borders with Myanmar, Thailand and Indonesia. The southernmost tip of the Indian mainland ($8^{\circ}4'38''\text{N}$, $77^{\circ}31'56''\text{E}$) is just south of Kanyakumari, while the

Most rivers in India originate from four major watersheds in India. These three river systems are fed by more than 5000 glaciers.
