Finasteride In the United States, finasteride and minoxidil are the only two FDA-approved drugs for the treatment of male pattern hair loss. Finasteride, sold under the brand names Proscar (5 mg) and Propecia (1 mg) among others, is a medication used to treat pattern hair loss and benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH). It can also be used to treat excessive hair growth in women. It is usually taken orally but there are topical formulations for patients with hair loss, designed to minimize systemic exposure by acting specifically on hair follicles. It develops in up to 80% of Caucasian men aged 70 and over.

Hair transplantation differs from skin grafting in that grafts contain almost all of the epidermis and dermis surrounding the hair follicle, and many tiny grafts are transplanted rather than a single strip of skin.

Along with dutasteride, finasteride is a widely dispensed 5 α -reductase inhibitor. As such, it is an antiandrogen that works by decreasing the production of dihydrotestosterone (DHT) by about 70% in serum, 90% in prostate.

Hair loss Typically at least the head is involved. Minoxidil is not effective for other causes of hair Hair loss, also known as alopecia or baldness, refers to a loss of hair from part of the head or body. Inflammation or scarring is not usually present. Hair loss in some people causes psychological distress. The severity of hair loss can vary from a small area to the entire body. The longer the hair has stopped growing, the less likely minoxidil will regrow hair. approved by the FDA

In addition to DHT, finasteride also inhibits the production of several anticonvulsant neurosteroids including allopregnanolone, androstanediol, and tetrahydrodeoxycorticosterone.

Alopecia areata Psychological stress and illness are possible factors in bringing on alopecia areata in individuals at risk, but in most cases there is no obvious trigger. In a few cases, all the hair on the scalp is lost (alopecia totalis), or all body hair is lost (alopecia universalis). In some men, sexual

dysfunction may persist after stopping the medication. It may also hide the early symptoms of certain forms of prostate cancer.

Hair transplantation patients may benefit with preoperative topical minoxidil application and vitamins. For several days prior to surgery the patient refrains from using any Hair transplantation is a surgical technique that removes hair follicles from one part of the body, called the 'donor site', to a bald or balding part of the body known as the 'recipient site'. The technique is primarily used to treat male pattern baldness. In this minimally invasive procedure, grafts containing hair follicles that are genetically resistant to balding (like the back of the head) are transplanted to the bald scalp 3f3e5d6e2c

Causes of hair loss that occurs with scarring or inflammation include fungal infection, lupus erythematosus, radiation therapy, and sarcoidosis.
