A bombsight has to estimate the path the bomb will take after release from the aircraft. The two primary forces during its fall are gravity and air drag, which make the path of the bomb through the air roughly parabolic. There are additional factors such as changes in air density and wind that may be considered, but they are concerns only for bombs that spend a significant portion of a minute falling through the air. Those effects can be minimized by reducing the fall time by low-level bombing or by increasing the speed of the bombs. Those effects are combined in the dive bomber.  
2fe6808872 A sling has a small cradle or pouch in the middle of two retention cords, where a projectile is placed. There is a loop on the end of one side of the retention cords. Depending on the design of the sling, either the middle finger or the wrist is placed through a loop on the end of one cord, and a tab at the end of the other cord is placed between the thumb and forefinger. The sling is swung in an arc, and the tab released at a precise moment. This action releases the projectile to fly inertially and ballistically towards the target. Coriolis force rotation of the Earth can be seen indirectly through the motion of a Foucault pendulum. In a reference frame with clockwise rotation, the force acts to the left of the motion of the object. This deflection (clockwise in the Northern Hemisphere and counterclockwise in the Southern Hemisphere) significantly influences large-scale circulation of winds and ocean currents. A practical application of the Coriolis effect is the mass flow meter In physics, the Coriolis force is a pseudo-force that acts on objects in motion within a frame of reference that rotates with respect to an inertial frame. Early in the 20th century, the term Coriolis force began to be used in connection with meteorology. Because of Earth's rotation, the moving object does not travel in a straight line relative to the Earth's surface but follows a curved path. Deflection of an object due to the Coriolis force is called the Coriolis effect. On Earth, the Coriolis force will affect the movement of air and water over long distance. Though recognized previously by others, the mathematical expression for the Coriolis force appeared in an 1835 paper by French scientist Gaspard-Gustave de Coriolis, in connection with the theory of water wheels.
