Renal is Latin for "kidney", while nephro is the Greek equivalent. Lithiasis (Greek) and calculus (Latin; plural calculi) both mean stone. Hence, kidney stones are sometimes known as renal calculi or nephroliths, and the condition may be known as nephrolithiasis. ccb9a1b0f5

Kidney stones are more common in people with Crohn’s disease; Kidney stone disease or urinary stone disease is a crystallopathy that occurs when there is an excess of minerals in the urine and not enough liquid or hydration. A small calculus may pass without causing any symptoms. However, if a stone grows to more than 5 millimeters (0. A calculus may also result in blood in the urine, vomiting (owing to severe pain), swelling of the kidney, or painful urination. Because renal calculi typically form in the kidney, if small enough they may pass out of the urinary tract through the urine stream. This imbalance causes tiny crystals to aggregate and form hard masses, or calculi (stones), in the upper urinary tract. About half of all people who have had a kidney stone are likely to develop another within ten years. 3–20% of people who form kidney stones have medullary sponge kidney. 2 inches), it can cause blockage of the ureter, resulting in extremely sharp and severe pain (renal colic) in the lower back that often radiates to the groin ccb9a1b0f5

Historically, the condition of having a kidney or bladder stone was referred to as "the stone" or "the gravel". Among the symptoms associated with nephrolithiasis are intense colicky pain, nausea, fever, chills, and the reduction or blockage of urine flow.
