Several subspecies have been described, but there is extensive individual variation in plumage. Although birds in the north of the range are larger than in the south, the difference is clinal and the northern white-crowned shrike may be monotypic. 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== References == Eggs have a long history of use as food, following the history of the domestic chicken, and recipes that include boiled eggs are found in the first known cookbook, *De re coquinaria*, in which at least one recipe calls for the use of preserved boiled eggs. The white-throated nightjar was formerly known as *Eurostopodus albogularis* but was later reclassified to *E. mystacalis*. Some texts may still refer to this species as *Eurostopodus mystacalis albogularis*. Before 2002, this species was regarded as conspecific with New Caledonian nightjar *Eurostopodus exul* and Solomons nightjar *Eurostopodus nigripennis*. However, later research separated the three into their own species based on differences in calls and song, and morphology. Since then, *E. mystacalis* has remained monotypic.

== Origin ==

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and nestlings of birds. The nonbreeding adult has a white head and neck. The upper sides of the neck have white lines along the base of the gular pouch, and the lower fore neck has a pale yellowish patch. The nominate subspecies in its breeding plumage has a white head with a yellowish wash on the crown. The pink skin around the eyes becomes dull and gray in the nonbreeding season. The nape and neck are dark maroon-brown. The male and female are similar, but the female is slightly smaller d59c5dcc69

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
