

What Does Clonidine Do

Moxonidine clonidine binds to both receptors with near equal affinity. Moxonidine has an affinity for I1 that is 33 times greater than $\alpha 2$, compared to clonidine

Clonidine was patented in 1961 and came into medical use in 1966. It is available as a generic medication... Common side effects include dry mouth, dizziness, headaches, hypotension, and sleepiness. Severe side effects may include hallucinations, heart arrhythmias, and confusion. If rapidly stopped, withdrawal effects may occur, such as a dangerous rise in blood pressure. Use during pregnancy or breastfeeding is not recommended. Clonidine lowers blood pressure by stimulating $\alpha 2$ -adrenergic receptors and imidazoline receptors in the brain, which results in relaxation of many arteries.
