In 1912, the Association of Iron and Steel Electrical Engineers sponsored the first Cooperative Safety Congress, which took place in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The approximately 200 attendees, representing industry and government, resolved to “organize and create a permanent body for the promotion of the safety to... The basic strategy of a Safe System approach is to ensure that in the event of a crash, the impact energies remain below the threshold likely to produce either death or serious injury. This threshold will vary from crash scenario to crash scenario, depending upon the level of protection offered to the road users involved.
