Uterine prolapse suspension (hysteropexy); removal of the uterus (partial or supra-cervical hysterectomy) with surgical fixation of the vaginal vault to a nearby pelvic structure; Uterine prolapse is a form of pelvic organ prolapse in which the uterus and a portion of the upper vagina protrude into the vaginal canal and, in severe cases, through the opening of the vagina. Prevalence, based on physical exam alone, is estimated to be approximately 14%. Risk factors include older age, pregnancy, vaginal childbirth, obesity, chronic constipation, and chronic cough. It is most often caused by injury or damage to structures that hold the uterus in place within the pelvic cavity. Symptoms may include vaginal fullness, pain with sexual intercourse, difficulty urinating, and urinary incontinence

Treatment options for uterine fibroids include observation or medical therapy, such a GnRH agonist, hysterectomy, uterine artery embolization, and high-intensity focused ultrasound ablation. If the uterus and ovaries are to remain intact, vaginectomy will leave a canal and opening suitable for draining menstrual discharge. Otherwise, as in genital nullification, a hysterectomy must be performed to avoid the danger of retaining menstrual discharge within the body. In the latter case, thorough removal of vaginal lining is necessary to avoid continued secretion within the body. Often used to refer to phalloplasty, metoidioplasty, or vaginectomy, sex reassignment surgery can also more broadly refer to many procedures an individual may have, such as chest reconstruction, hysterectomy, or oophorectomy. They often cause bulk-related symptoms, which can be characterized by back pain, heaviness in the pelvic area, abdominal bloating. Hysterectomy These procedures Hysterectomy is the surgical removal of the uterus and cervix. Nearly 68 percent were performed for conditions such as endometriosis, irregular bleeding, and uterine fibroids. These procedures are usually performed by a gynecologist. These procedures may also involve removal of the ovaries (oophorectomy), fallopian tubes (salpingectomy), and other surrounding structures. The terms "partial" or "total" hysterectomy are lay terms that incorrectly describe the addition or omission of oophorectomy at the time of hysterectomy. It is the second most commonly performed gynecological surgical procedure, after cesarean section, in the United States. Supracervical hysterectomy refers to the removal of the uterus while the cervix is spared. Removal of the uterus is a form of sterilization, rendering the patient unable to bear children (as does removal of ovaries and fallopian tubes) and has surgical risks as well as long-term effects, so the surgery is normally recommended only when other treatment options are not available or have failed. Endometrial ablation is typically used to address abnormal uterine bleeding, which can be a symptom of multiple health conditions. This procedure is usually performed by a gynecologist. Endometrial ablation does not cure any medical conditions, it is used to reduce symptoms that conditions cause. This procedure can cause patients to experience permanent side effects and

long-term complications. It is estimated that around 500,000 patients undergo endometrial ablation. Endometrial ablation is a minimally invasive gynecological surgical procedure that ablates or destroys the endometrium, or lining, of the uterus. Treatments to address abnormal uterine bleeding, the only other option being hysterectomy. This destruction causes the formation of scar tissue, preventing the endometrium from regrowing. Uterine artery embolization complications is comparable to that of myomectomy or hysterectomy. The procedure is primarily done for the treatment of uterine fibroids and adenomyosis. Other reasons for uterine artery embolization are postpartum hemorrhage and uterine arteriovenous malformations. Compared to surgical treatment for fibroids such as a hysterectomy, in which a woman's uterus is removed, uterine artery embolization may be beneficial in women who wish to retain their uterus. The advantage of somewhat faster recovery time is offset by a higher rate of minor complications. Uterine artery embolization (UAE, uterine fibroid embolization, or UFE) is a procedure in which an interventional radiologist uses a catheter to deliver small particles that block the blood supply to the uterine body. 6a528b8cc0

Vaginal evisceration is typically obvious upon presentation, as intestine (typically ileum) can be seen protruding from the introitus.
