Allergies, exposure to environmental A nasal concha (; pl. A concha is any of the scrolled spongy bones of the nasal passages in vertebrates. The conchae are shaped like an elongated seashell, which gave them their name (Latin concha from Greek κόγχη). The term concha refers to the actual bone; when covered by soft tissue and mucosa, and functioning, a concha is termed a turbinate 4730647b21

In the human nose, the nasal conchae divide the nasal airway into four groove-like air passages and play a major role in conditioning inspired air by increasing surface area to warm, humidify, and filter the air before it reaches the lungs. As a ciliated mucous membrane with shallow blood supply, the nasal mucosa cleans, humidifies and warms the inhaled air in preparation for the lungs. 4730647b21 A rapidly dilating arteriolar circulation to these bones may lead to a sharp increase in the pressure within, in response to acute cooling of the body core.
