== Risks == 6e461ac89f The contamination was the result of the activities of a local asbestos factory, part of the Turner & Newall (T&N) group (often referred to by the name of its founders, J. W. Roberts Ltd.) and occurred between the end of the 19th century and 1959 when the factory eventually closed. At its peak the factory had 250 employees. At least 300 former employees are believed to have died from asbestos-related illnesses, and a number of cancer deaths in the Armley area were traced to the factory in 1988 as a result of an investigation by the Yorkshire Evening Post. The estate was found to have the highest incidence in the country of mesothelioma. As the interval between exposure and diagnosis can be up to 50 years the number of further deaths which may occur due to the factory's emissions or residual dust since its closure cannot be predicted. 6e461ac89f Serpentine subgroup is a set of common rock-forming hydrous magnesium iron phyllosilicate ((Mg,Fe)3Si2O5(OH)4) minerals, resulting from the metamorphism of the minerals that are contained in mafic to ultramafic rocks. They may contain minor amounts of other elements including chromium, manganese, cobalt or nickel. In mineralogy and gemology, serpentine may refer to any of the 20 varieties belonging to the serpentine subgroup. Owing to admixture, these varieties are not always easy to individualize, and distinctions are not usually made. There are three important mineral polymorphs of serpentine: antigorite, lizardite and chrysotile. 6e461ac89f Archaeological studies have found evidence of asbestos being used as far back as the Stone Age to strengthen ceramic pots, but large-scale mining began at the end of the 19th century when manufacturers and builders began using asbestos for its desirable physical properties. Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006 include a greater emphasis on training requiring anyone who may come into contact with asbestos in the course of their work to be given suitable training. The pieces of legislation the regulations revoked and replaced were the Control of Asbestos at Work Regulations 2002 (SI 2002/2675), the Asbestos (Licensing) Regulations 1983 (SI 1983/1649) and the Asbestos (Prohibitions) Regulations 1992 (SI 1992/3067). The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006 (SI 2006/2739) came into force in the United Kingdom on 13 November 2006 and brought together a number of other asbestos related pieces of legislation. The recently published 'Asbestos: The survey guide' (HSG264) is complementary to these regulations. This has been superseded by the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 (SI 2012/632). Greater restrictions were also placed on the amount of exposure workers could be exposed to in the form of 'control limits'. When work with asbestos is being carried out the regulations place a requirement on employers and self-employed workers to prevent exposure to asbestos fibres. Inhalation of asbestos fibres can lead to various dangerous lung conditions, including mesothelioma, asbestosis, and lung cancer. Amosite and crocidolite are considered the most hazardous asbestos fiber types; however, chrysotile asbestos has also produced tumors in animals and is a recognized cause of asbestosis and malignant mesothelioma in humans, and mesothelioma has been observed in people who were occupationally exposed to chrysotile, family members of the occupationally exposed, and residents who lived close to asbestos factories and mines. 6e461ac89f One of the major issues relating to asbestos in civil proceedings is the latency of asbestos-related diseases. A National Institutes of Health of 421 people reported a latency period of 14 to 72 years from exposure to asbestos to mesothelioma diagnosis. Most countries have limitation periods to bar actions that are taken long after the cause of action has lapsed. For example, in Malaysia the time period to file a tort action is six years from the time the tort occurred. Due to several asbestos-related actions, countries such as Australia have amended their laws relating to limitations to accumulate starting from time of discovery rather than time when the cause of action accrued. As of 2013, about 125 million people worldwide have been exposed to asbestos at work. Asbestos exposure and the onset of cancer are generally separated by about 40 years. Washing the clothing of someone who worked with asbestos also increases the risk.
